Children's Worship

Children, age 2-3rd grade, will be dismissed during services. They will check in at the gates in *Glory Factory*.

The 1st-3rd grade children will need to be picked up following 1st service and taken to their *Hiz Kidz* classes.

Check-in Procedures for Sunday Bible Classes

ABC's will be checked in at the nursery window in the hallway south of the auditorium, *Toddlers* will be checked in at the door of their classroom (just outside the east door of the auditorium) and the rest of *Glory Factory* (Pre-school-K) will check in at either gate (last names beginning with A-L, just past the Toddler room and M-Z, by the trophy case).

Toddlers brought at Bible Class time will remain in class until the end of 2nd worship. *Hiz Kidz* check-in and out is as follows: Last names beginning with A-L are at the *top* of the south stairs (by the office and adult library) and M-Z are at the *bottom* of the north stairs.
