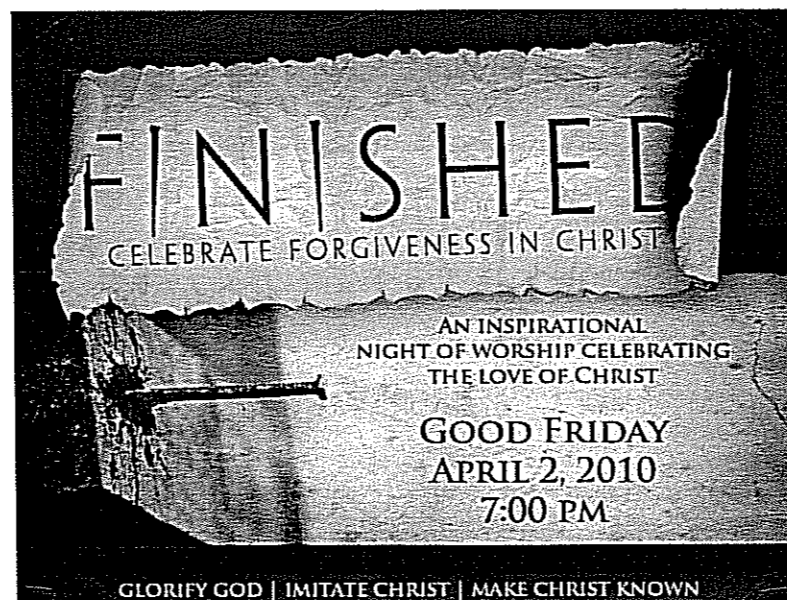
- The Auditorium Life Group will not be meeting tonight.

### Children's Worship

No attended nursery during 1<sup>st</sup> service. The Unattended Nursery is located in the room closest to the outside door and is wired so that you may hear the service. Children, age 2-3<sup>rd</sup> grade, will be dismissed during 1<sup>st</sup> service and all will check in at the Glory Factory gates.

Glory Factory children will be transitioned to class at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> service. The 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> grade children will need to be picked up following 1<sup>st</sup> service and taken to their Hiz Kidz classes.

During 2<sup>nd</sup> service, the Toddlers will be checked in at A117 and pre-school through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will check in at the Glory Factory gates.

Every 2nd Sunday of each month there will be no Children's Worship.

### Check-in Procedures for Sunday Bible Classes

ABC's will be checked in at the nursery window in the hallway south of the auditorium. Toddler classes are on either side of the Noah's Ark picture and they will be checked in at the doors of their classrooms. Toddlers brought at Bible Class time will be transitioned to the Toddler Worship Caring room and will be picked up there after 2<sup>nd</sup> service. The rest of Glory Factory (Pre-school-K) will check in at either gate (last names beginning with A-L, just past the Older Toddler room, and M-Z, by the trophy case) and will be picked up at the end of class. Hiz Kidz check-in and out is as follows: Last names beginning with A-L are at the top of the south stairs (by the office and adult library) and M-Z are at the bottom of the north stairs.
